## Palliative Medicine of Acadiana



Cared for **306** patients suffering from serious chronic illness and disease



Provided **1,180** patient encounters via a Nurse Practitioner and Social Worker



Established new on-site clinic for ease of access to services

Palliative Medicine of Acadiana was established to help those individuals faced with a serious, chronic illness who may not yet be hospice appropriate, but are in need of support.

## Acadiana's Center for Loss & Transition



Helped **32** children process and cope with loss through custom **Comfort Care Packages**



Served **2,665** individuals, free of charge, on their grief journey - yielding **\$279,774** in savings to the community



Hosted (5) 6-week workshops to meet increased grief needs in our community - supporting **50** additional individuals on their grief journey

Beyond hospice care, Acadiana's Center for Loss & Transition supports those individuals and families who may be dealing with a terminal or life altering diagnosis, or those who are grieving. The Center for Loss & Transition provides free grief counseling to anyone in our community - even if not on hospice services.
